

Revolutionary Hydro Power Generator from Australia:

The world needs clean energy: therefore new inventions which harness untapped natural sources of extractable energy in an environmentally friendly manner are the way of the future. The Kouris Centri Turbine (KCT) Generator is an Australian invention which creates hydro energy in a revolutionary new manner. In the core of natural phenomena such as tornadoes and whirlpools, there is a vortex of pressure circulating at rapid speeds. The KCT Generator is based on a realisation that clean energy can be extracted from water moving in a free vortex formation, much like a tornado or a whirlpool. Harnessing the spin of a vortex in the water, the KCT collects energy without interfering with the flow of the waterway along which it is placed.

A pilot generator installed in Victoria, Australia has demonstrated the ability to produce up to 11kWh per day, sufficient to power a small home but larger KCT's can power multiple homes and large factories. Recently the KCT was awarded 18 separate international patents including 10 key European countries. Ultimately, the development of the KCT Generator means the improvement of alternative power sources and the potential to increase the output and efficiency of existing hydro plants which currently supply more than 16% of the world's electricity.
